- **Start with Food:** Having a relaxing **dinner and/or drinks at a local restaurant** is a great place to start your bachelorette party. This allows everyone to get to know each other better and allows the bride to interact with her friends and family, play games, or share memories before the later festivities begin. There are options for virtually any type of cuisine or dining atmosphere in Indianapolis, whether you grab some pasta or pizza at an Italian restaurant or some appetizers, burgers and fries at a local pub. Some locations even combine the food, drink and fun, such as [Latitude 360](#) on the Northside, with dining, comedy, movies and bowling.

If you start the day early, or your bachelorette party is more of a weekend getaway, spend some time in the hotel **spa or salon** with your girlfriends. You could also do some **shopping in downtown Indianapolis** at many of the local retail shops or galleries. **Sporting events** are always a hit, such as an [Indians](#), [Colts](#), [Pacers](#), [Fever](#), [Fuel](#) or [Indy Eleven](#) game, as well as local **concerts** at [Banker's Life Fieldhouse](#), [Klipsch Music Center](#) or other local venues. For something more intimate, try a paint party such as [Painting with a Twist](#). If gaming is your thing, try a racing casino for your bachelorette party at [Indiana Grand](#) in Shelbyville or [Hoosier Park](#) in Anderson. You could even take in a comedy show at [Crackers](#), [Morty's](#) or [ComedySportz](#). Or there are options such as [The Pickled Pedaler](#), which offer the transportation, drinking and fun in one.

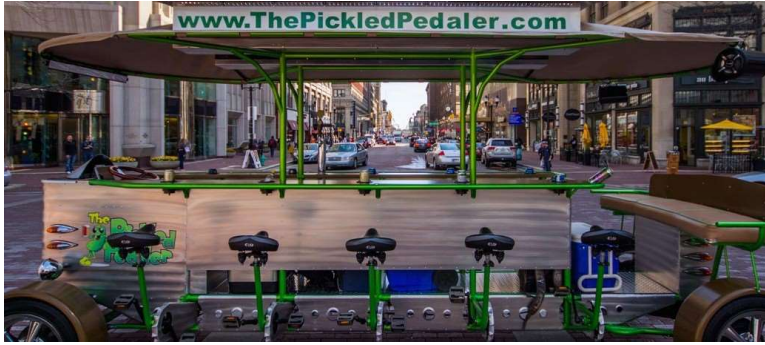

- **Hit the Bar:** If you're ready for more late-night cocktails and fun, consider one of the bachelorette party favorites in Indianapolis. [Howl at the Moon](#) and [Brick House](#) offer dueling pianos, live music and dancing. [Saddle Up](#), [8 Seconds Saloon](#) and [Cadillac Ranch](#) offer country music, line dancing and mechanical bulls. [Chatterbox](#), [The Jazz Kitchen](#) and [Slippery Noodle Inn](#) are some of the more popular bars that offer live jazz and blues music with food and drink options. For pub crawls, there are many bars within walking distance of each other in downtown Indianapolis off of [Meridian Street](#), [Georgia Street](#), [Mass Ave.](#) and in [Fountain Square](#), as well as in [Broad Ripple Village](#). You could also do a [brewery tour](#) or wine tasting tour at many of the local breweries and [wineries in central Indiana](#).
